I apologize for the lateness of this letter as it would normally have gone out in late July. Being that I slept in my own bed and was in front of my home computer only four days and nights in July, I hope you will pardon me. There is much to tell, so let's jump right into it!

### One more stateside prayer letter to go!

Our next prayer letter will be issued in late September, which is also about the time we plan to fly over. We aren't able to establish a precise departure date yet due to the fact that we are waiting on our sponsorship number which is needed for us to apply for visas. We have to carefully time the visa application process because we have 30 days to fly into the country once the applications are approved.

### Financial matters

At the time I write this, churches have committed to meet 93% of our support goal. That leaves us needing \$400 in monthly support, and I'm not at all worried about how or when it will come in. I'm just excited to find out which of the churches we've visited in the past 2½ years will be the ones God uses to supply the need.

We projected a need of just over \$17,000 in passage funds a few months back, and the Lord has provided just over \$10,000. We might not require as much per item as I initially budgeted for, but after talking with two missionaries already in the United Kingdom, it seems that I'll have enough "surprise" taxes and fees to swallow up anything I might perceive as extra funds!

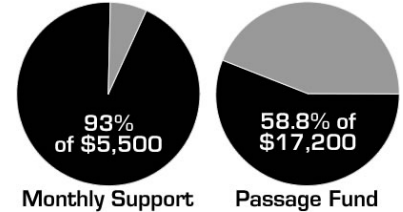
### Where we've been/where we're going

Since the last letter, we've made an interesting triangle of travel, touching the shores of the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans and Lake Superior. All told, deputation has taken me to 12 states I wouldn't have visited otherwise, taking my total of states visited to 42 (Tammy sits at 40 due to a trip that I made that she didn't). There are 12 more meetings on the calendar in eight different states.

### Praise reports & prayer requests

- God has really moved in several recent meetings. Pray for fruit that remains.
- Pray for more souls to be won through witnessing and as a result of preaching.
- On the past two Sundays alone, four churches have notified us of new support totaling \$515. That's almost 10% of our goal in an eight-day span!
- A dear couple allowed us to borrow a vehicle for our west coast travel which saved us \$2,500 in rental car fees. (Have you priced rental cars lately? It's crazy! We formerly were able to rent a full size at the airport for \$20/day, but the same vehicle is now \$90/day. You'd think they were made of *lumber* or something!)
- I really must praise God for the sustained providence of reliable vehicles and good health overall. In probably 60,000 miles traveled on the ground, we've had one flat tire and one minor brush with another vehicle ... that's all! The only meetings I have had to cancel due to my health was a string of five when I caught COVID last year. God has been so good. But He is always, only good!
